The Egg Cultural Association for contemporary art is pleased to announce HE FELL SILENT, a solo exhibition of the Estonian artist Katrin Koskaru concluding the 2016/17 season.

Koskaru's work consists mostly from drawings and paintings. Through her work she is looking into themes such as war and perpetual motion of violence. In her paintings the vicious increase of ruins, warlike atmosphere, personal and collective memories concerning war and diverse form of power are often reduced to an abstract form.

Katrin Koskaru, born in 1977, is an artist currently based in Estonia.

She holds a BA degree in Fine Art from the Estonian Academy of Arts, Tallinn and an MA in Painting from the Royal College of Art, London (2013). Koskaru's recent exhibitions include "Come to Close Quarters" at Marlborough London (2014), "War Poem" at Pascaline Mulliez Gallery in Paris (2016). Group exhibitions include "House For Hanging," with Margarita Glutzenberg and Sanja Todorovic at Westminster Waste, London (2016); "Explosive Standards" at La Petite Galerie, Paris (2015); "Can't Go On, Must Go On" at Tallinna Kunstihoone, Estonia (2014).
